

A. School Profile

Yong Fu Elementary School is located in Yongfu Village, Sanchong District, New Taipei City in Taiwan. It was established in 1981 with a school area of 18,189 square meters. The school grounds are pentagonal in shape, hence the school emblem is designed as a pentagon.

The school consists of six regular grades, with approximately 8 to 12 classes per grade. There are also 2 classes for special education, 2.5 classes for resource integration, and 2 classes for kindergarten. In total, the school has 62.5 classes and approximately 1,551 students, with about 150 faculty and staff members.

"Environmental Sustainability", "School Internationalization", and "Intelligent Technology" are three main visions of YFES. The school aims to cultivate students who possess technological and humanistic literacy, international cultural understanding, and interdisciplinary and diverse capabilities as global citizens.
